FIFA > USSF > US Youth Soccer > PA West > Hampton Soccer Club (different from PIAA / WPIAL: HMS / HHS)





COACHING



Soccer is about creative individual skills combined with communication and team effort

Practices usually start with warm-up, individual skills, small group drills, applying small group drills into larger scheme of game situations.

Coaches are encouraged to avoid 'lines, laps and lectures'








